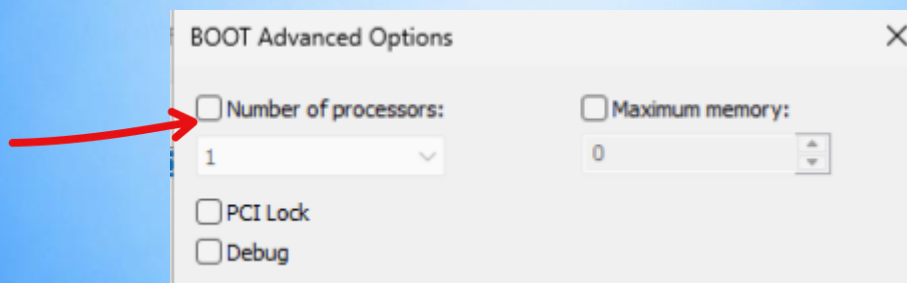
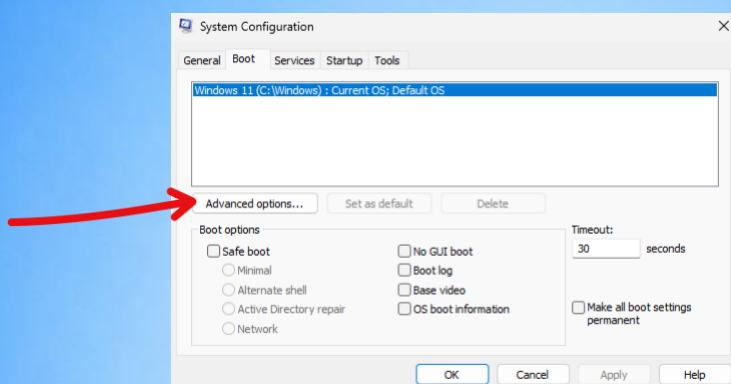


The wrong CPU Activation Tip 🚫

For a long time, a tip has frequently resurfaced on the internet regarding how to correctly configure the number of CPU cores.

You navigate via MSCONFIG to the "Boot" tab and open "Advanced options."



Here, you are supposed to check the box and select the maximum number of processors. This is supposed to make the PC run faster. However, this is unnecessary. If the box is left unchecked, Windows already automatically utilizes the maximum number. By default, the box is unchecked! The settings here are intended for testing purposes only.

Strangely enough, no one has ever suggested setting the maximum memory.

"Standard" without the checkbox is also the maximum.
